Domaine Rossignol Trapet

The Domaine is now owned by two brothers Nicholas and David Rossignol Trapet. This is an excellent source of first class quality. The surge in quality, at Rossignol Trapet, is due to their conversion to biodynamic farming, beginning in 1998, with the whole Domaine under the new regime by 2004.

As a result the wines are much finer and purer than they used to be. We were really impressed with their range of wines and are very happy to promote them.

Their barrel policy is 20% new oak for Village wines, 30% new oak for 1er Cru, and Grand Cru is 40/50% new oak.

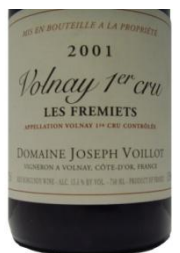


Domaine Joseph Viollot

The Domaine Joseph Viollot is based in Volnay with vines on the east to southeast facing slopes composed of limestone and clay.

This Domaine is just over 10 hectares is spread across 32 parcels in Volnay, Pommard, Beaune and Meursault and produces 17 different appellations. The ageing is done in oak barrels with 25% approximately new oak.

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Domaine David Duband

David started working with his father in 1991, he has been in the sole charge of the Domaine from 1995. Everything is hand-picked. 90% of the vintage is de-stalked, 10% kept in whole bunches and these are at the bottom of the vats. The malolactic generally ends in the spring and the wine stays on its lees until the summer.

As the cellar temperature is 7° clarifies itself producing a very bright natural in so it is unnecessary to do a collage or to filter. All the bottling is done at the Domaine.

The barrels are 60% new wood, 30% 1 year old barrels that all are from Berthomieu.

Domaine Tollot Beaut

The 24 hectare Domaine of Tollot-Beaut sits modestly in the centre of Chorey-lès-Beaune. Today the 'front of house' face of the Domaine is Nathalie Tollot. Nathalie is the fifth generation to run the Domaine that has been run from the same premises for over 100 years - since late 19th century - though parts of the cellars are as much as 250 years old.

Today the use of oak is to quite a subtle effect; there is no toast, rather there is padding out of the palate, an extra fatness and apparent richness that makes seemingly 'glossy' wines - it makes the wines very attractive in their youth with no apparent downside from ageing. The villages and regional wines stay in barrel for 16-18 months, and receive 20% new oak, the quantity of new oak reaches a maximum of 60% for the grand crus.

Domaine Sauzet

Etienne Sauzet, the founder of the Domaine (1903-1975) created a Domaine of 12 hectares starting with an inherited 3 hectares from his family. His granddaughter, Jeannine married Gerard Boudot in 1974 and in 1975 Gerard assumed responsibility of the Domaine on Etienne's death. It was Gerard who introduced Domaine-bottling and to whom Burgundy expert *Anthony Hanson* once described as "the most dazzling white winemaker in Burgundy".

The Domaine today is made up of 7.01 hectares. The cellars are air-conditioned, temperature reduced to 10° during harvest and first fermentations which is at a classic 18-20°. A long débourage, fine lees and battonage. Use of oak is modest, it never comes close to dominating – 25% Villages, approximately 35-40% for the 1er Crus, depending on vintage and 50% for the Grand Cru. The average age of the vines in 2003 was 33 years.
